4.1	 Gaelcholáiste Nua School Building Project Update The Capital and Buildings Officer, Mr. Padraig O'Sullivan provided the following update: The Design Team are currently preparing tender documents for the project which are due for submission to the Department of Education and Skills (DoES) on November 8th 2019. To avoid potential delays while waiting for the approval to go to tender it is anticipated Kerry ETB will request approval to commence prequalification of prospective tenderers for Main Contractor and also M&E Specialist sub-contractor to run parallel with this approval stage on November 8th 2019 once the documents are lodged with the DoES. The Enabling Works Contract is currently being completed by the contractor (Denis Moriarty The Kerries Ltd.), and is due for completion 		

	 by end of October. Issues currently being addressed around Eircom Cable diversion and termination within University Hospital Kerry. Kerry ETB have been advised that this will involve about two day's work with an outage to facilitate the changeover. The Board noted this update.
4.2	 Listowel School Accommodation The Capital and Buildings Officer, Mr. Padraig O'Sullivan provided the following update: DoES currently accessing Kerry ETB Additional School Accommodation (ASA) application. DoES senior architect to liaise with Kerry ETB to schedule a meeting with Kerry County Council Planning Department to discuss the possible impact on future planning decisions if Kerry ETB were to acquire the property adjacent to the school grounds. Student numbers scheduled to increase in the coming academic year 2020/2021 for Coláiste na Ríochta. Kerry ETB are to apply to the DoES for temporary accommodation to meet the growing needs of the school.
	Ríochta, Mr. Stephen Goulding, on the increased enrolments. The Board welcomed this update.
4.3	 Listellick National School Building Project Update The Capital and Buildings Officer, Mr. Padraig O'Sullivan provided the following update: Stage 2A Report lodged to the DoES on August 23rd 2019. Kerry ETB are awaiting a date for Stage 2A meeting with the DoES in Tullamore. It is anticipated, following this meeting and approval to proceed, the Design Team will lodge the planning application with Kerry County Council. Completion of construction based on current timelines is projected as February 2022. This update was noted by the Board.
4.4	 Killorglin Community College Proposal Update The Capital and Buildings Officer, Mr. Padraig O'Sullivan provided the following update: ➤ Meeting held on September 27th 2019 with Killorglin Sport Complex Management Committee. ➤ At this meeting there was general agreement that matters pertaining to the current lease, which commenced on March 15th 1983 for a 99 year

	 term, must be formalised given the current management structure of Killorglin Sports Complex and how matters have evolved since the original lease was put in place. Kerry ETB's legal agents are currently progressing matters. The current lease may have to be surrendered with a new lease for the remaining term on the existing lease being granted by the Board of the ETB to the Killorglin Sports and Leisure Centre Company Limited by Guarantee. As part of this process Kerry ETB would be seeking positions for two Directors on the Board of the company. Further meeting scheduled for November 8th 2019 to progress matters.

A further update will be provided at the December 3 rd 2019 Board Meeting.

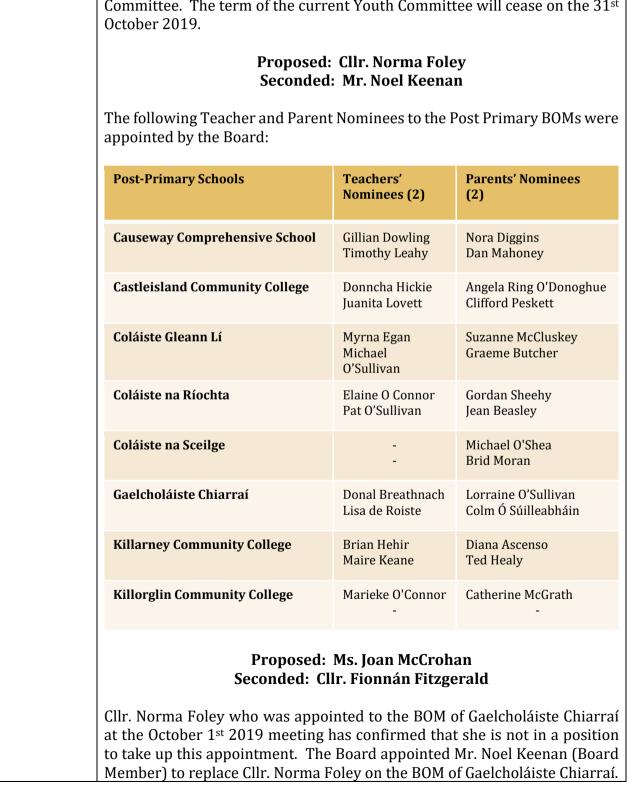

Specifically, he advised, that an option of relocating the ETB Head Office to the South Campus buildings is being considered as part of this proposal. The lease on the current ETB Head Office building expires in 2027 with a break clause option for 2025. Board Members noted this inclusion in the business case and while a possible permanent location for the ETB Head Office was welcome, the accessibility for the public and proximity of the current ETB Head Office to the town centre, train and bus station were highlighted and noted.

Padraig then referenced a Kerry VEC receipt re Raheen Technical School dated and signed by the then Financial

	Controller, Mr. Liam Moriarty. It is believed that this nominal amount is for the full sale of the site. Reference was also made to correspondence with Murphy Ramsey Walsh Solicitors re this matter. Board approval is required to formally rectify this title thus disposing of Kerry ETB's interest in this land in accordance with Section 12(2)(n) of the ETB Act 2013 (<i>'the acquisition,</i> <i>holding and disposal of land, or any interest in land'</i>).
