ACTIVITY 7

LOW POLY MASK

AGE: 10 - 14 years | ACTIVITY LENGTH: 1 Hour

MATERIALS REQUIRED

Printer Paper sheets Thick paper or thin card Stick glue Scissors Adhesive tape A ball-point pen and a ruler A piece of cord or elastic

Step 1

Cut out the shapes provided carefully. Make sure to cut around only the black lines, do not cut through the thick grey lines. Alternatively, you could scan the pages containing the shapes and print them off if you wish to retain the stencils provided here.

Step 2

Now, glue the pieces you have cut out onto your card.

Step 3

When the glue is dry, cut the pieces out of the card, again, do not cut through the thick grey lines.

Step 4

Hold the ruler along each thick grey line and run the ballpoint pen along the line a couple of times. And fold along the line.

Step 5

You will notice that the tabs on the shapes are numbered. Glue the tabs to the underside of their corresponding number on the other piece, like with like with the tab on the inside face of the mask.





Step 6

Punch out the two holes and add a length of cord or elastic to hold on your mask.

Step 7

Decorate as you wish. Your low-poly mask is complete.
