Job Description

- **1.** Provide ISL Communication Support to Deaf learners at the KES Assistive Technology VTOS Programme where the tutors and other learners are hearing.
- **2.** Teach basic ISL to the other groups of learners, and staff as appropriate, so as to facilitate inclusion and good communication amongst all learners.
- **3.** Support Deaf learners and hearing staff so that the learners have full access to all aspects of the curriculum.
- **4.** Support teachers and the Coordinator in the classroom and in preparing materials.
- 5. Carry out all other reasonable duties at the request of the Coordinator / AEO / CEO
