## **ACTIVITY 4**

# **JAR PAINTING**

Activity provided by creative tutor Marie Cronin

AGE: 10 - 14 years | ACTIVITY LENGTH: 1 Hour

## **MATERIALS REQUIRED**

Jars - sauce jars, jam jars or any unusual shaped food jars
Cellotape
Paintbrushes
Jar for water
Kitchen paper
Acrylic paints (available in Dealz €1.50 euro)
Scissors
Pictures from colouring book/photos
Battery tea light (optional)

## STEP 1

Collect some clear glass jars.

## STEP 2

Wash glass jars thoroughly, letting them soak in warm soapy water for 20 minutes to remove any labels. If having difficulty, ask an adult for help.

#### STEP 3

Attach a piece of cellotape top and bottom to your chosen picture. You can also use an old photo of your favourite pet. (One that you are allowed to cut up)

#### STEP 4

Stick your picture/photo inside the jar. (See photo number 2).







## STEP 5

Paint over each detail of picture/photo from the outside.

## STEP 6

Leave each colour dry before applying the next one beside it. When all paint is dry, carefully remove the picture/photo from inside.

#### STEP 7

A battery tea light can be placed inside the jar for a glowing effect.
